In addition the following work has now been completed.

1. A water filter has been fitted to the pond on phase 2.
2. A light has been installed in the pond on phase 2.
3. 2 lights have been installed to illuminate the trees around the pond on phase 2.
4. The sprinkler system adjacent to the pond on phase 2 has been refurbished.
5. A number of leaks found in the sprinkler system on phase 2 have now been repaired.
6. A further light has been installed under one of the bushes on phase 1.

7. A leak was detected in the pool on phase 2. The leak was traced to the pipework used to remove debris from the bottom of the pool during routine maintenance. A blanking plug has been fitted to this open pipe to stop further leakage.
8. The concrete bases of the lights on phase 2 have now been painted to match the ones on phase 1
9. The filters on both pools are being emptied and replaced with new sand/gravel.
